What three issues divided the North and South and led to the Civil War?

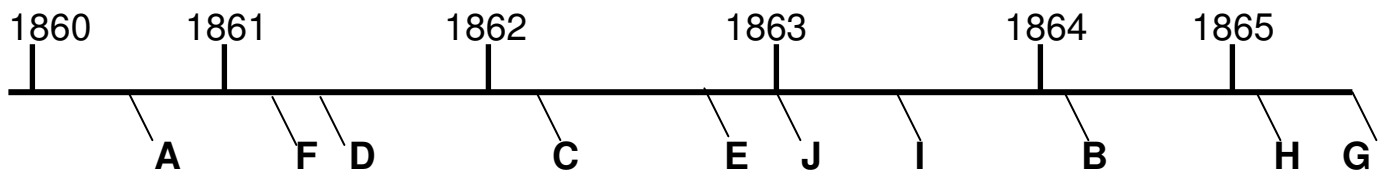
Draw a line through the incorrect issues.
